

Building Services Department RESIDENTIAL - REQUIRMENTS FOR OCCUPANCY -

SINGLE DWELLING UNIT / SEASONAL COTTAGE

Definition:

A person may occupy or permit to be occupied a building intended for residential occupancy that has not been fully completed at the date of occupancy. Occupancy requirements may include but are not limited to the following: (for more detailed information consult the Ontario Building Code, Division C, Part 1, Section 1,3.3.2):

- ** Heat and water turned on and operational (complete with thermostatic mixing valve). 1.
- 2. ** One completely operational and sanitary bathroom facility. Bathroom to be complete with door, water closet, sink, tub/shower and trim.
- ** Kitchen area to have resilient flooring and sink installed and operational. 3.
- Smoke detectors installed in appropriate locations and operational. Carbon monoxide detectors shall 4. also be installed, where required in accordance with the Ontario Building Code (OBC).
- Building must be completely closed in and exterior doors are to be equipped with dead bolt. 5.
- All items relating to personal safety must be in place (eq. handrails, decks, steps, etc.) Where 6. decks/steps are not provided or completed, doors must be secured to prevent egress. Where the adjacent grade exceeds 23 5/8".
- ** Water System: 7.

Where there is a private water system, there shall be a potable water test by an approved authority received by the Building Services Department prior to occupancy being approved. Tests to be conducted shall confirm "0" E-coli and "0" Coliform.

- 8. Compliance must be met for all previously noted work orders, deficiencies and notices.
- Minimum of one (1) Ontario Building Code compliant, completed entrance/exit into dwelling. 9.
- Septic Use Permit Certificate of approval if applicable. (Should be provided to Building Inspector by Algoma Health Unit, AHU)
- 11. ** Completion of ventilation systems (eg. Bathroom fan, range hood, heat recovery, etc.)
- ** Electrical Safety Authority final inspection. 12.
- ** Radon Gas Test results. 13.
- Final Inspection by the Building Department is required following completion of all work. 14.

NOTES: ** These items MAY not be required for a seasonal cottage

Any variation to these requirements will be by written consent of the Chief Building Official only.
