

New Recycling Containers

Recycling bins have been located at the dumpster locations on Dunlop Shores Road and Stanrock Road. Many thanks to one of our ELWOA members Lorraine Roulston, for pursuing this matter!

The two bins are well marked. One will accept cardboard and boxboard while the second, the commingled bin, includes all food plastic packaging with numbers 1-6. Remember NOT to include straws, plastic film, Styrofoam, scrap metal, E-waste, hard plastic or household hazardous waste.

Please flatten cardboard and boxboard to save space. Remove lids and screw tops from jars and bottles. Crush cans, if possible, with loose sharp can tops placed inside. **Rinse** all food containers, not only to ensure our bins are contaminate-free for useable markets, but also to keep animals from being attracted to the site.

Daryl Halloch, the city's new Environmental Manager of Environmental Services states, "Due to my lack of resources to monitor the bins and determine the regular pattern of emptying them, I require recyclers to inform me when bins are nearing capacity.
